Leitrim Organic Farmers' Co-op is an organic selling cooperative in Ireland that has expanded to include training, agricultural advice, activism and influencing policy. The main goal was to find outlets for their organic produce so they developed markets in different ways. The cooperative set up one of the first Farmers' markets in the country and collaborated with larger processors. They worked with them to supply products outside of Ireland – in the Netherlands and the UK. Those contracts are still in place today.

The cooperative has been able to reduce rural isolation because they run discussion groups and events improving social interaction. Social farming has also developed in the region, mainly because of their influence. The farm is used in a holistic way of dealing with the traumas and difficulties in the lives of people with special needs. The cooperative was involved in work at European level, trying to formulate new policies especially through the Common Agricultual Policy (CAP) to make it more reflective of their own ambitions. Small farming traditions of Europe should be enshrined in law.
